The aforementioned having been noted, I can imagine that your membership on the board of the Supervisory Council and your position of chairlady on the board may have become untenable in light of your legal representation of a member of parliament in an ongoing criminal investigation against that member of parliament which may be connected the Bureau of Telecommunication and Post. In light this of your resignation from the Supervisory Council is hereby accepted.
