On March 17, 2021, Parliament received e-mail correspondence from you (our reference: IS/506/2020-2021) regarding a request from the State Secretary R. Knops that the Government of Sint Maarten and the Parliament of Sint Maarten reconfirm their commitment to the Country Package and the trajectory for the establishment of Kingdom Law Caribbean Body for Reforms and Development (COHO) (reference: 2021-0000148859). The Parliament of Sint Maarten is hereby informing you as follows.


On December 14, 2020 Parliament informed you that there was a majority of factions and its Members in Parliament that expressed its support to continue on the trajectory related to the draft consensus Kingdom Law COHO and the signing of the Country Package Sint Maarten and related agreements. By means of this letter Parliament would like to inform you that a number of factions representing a majority of Members in Parliament, in the continuation of its Central Committee meeting no. 17 of March 19, 2021, expressed once again their continued support for the Government of Sint Maarten to continue the implementation of the agreements that are regulated in the Country Package Sint Maarten as well as continuing on the legislative trajectory related to the establishment of the consensus Kingdom Law COHO.



Parliament hopes to have fully informed you on this matter and look forward to the continuation of this process started by the Government.
